Szanowni Państwo,

Jesteśmy szkółką specjalizującą się w produkcji roślin wrzosowatych. Przed ponad 20 laty jako pierwsi w Europie rozpoczęliśmy na szeroką skalę uprawiać materiał szkółkarski mnożony we własnej szkółce metodą mikrosadzonki. Zgromadzone na przestrzeni wielu lat doświadczenie pozwoliło nam na dopracowanie technologii zapewniającej wysoką jakość roślin. Obecnie wielkość naszej produkcji to ponad 2 mln sztuk roślin. W głównej mierze jest to młodzież szkółkarska do dalszej uprawy. Około 20% roślin pozostaje w szkółce i po dorosnięciu oferowane jest jako materiał starszy. Młode sadzonki prawie w całości, a materiał starszy w około 40% eksportujemy do 25 krajów Europy, a także do krajów azjatyckich. Głównym naszym produktem jest rododendron - ponad 100 odmian. Ponadto w produkcji posiadamy 30 odmian azali, magnolie, azalie japońskie, pierisy i inne rośliny wrzosowate.

Drugim dużym działem produkcji, który cieszy się coraz większym zainteresowaniem jest borówka wysoka - tak młode, jaki i dorosłe krzewy. Borówka jest również rozmnażana metodą mikrosadzonki. Obecnie w ofercie znajduje się ponad 30 odmian w ogólnej ilości ponad 1 mln sztuk. Trzecim działem jest materiał iglasty szczepiony - ponad 60 pozycji.

Szczególny nacisk kładziemy na wysoką jakość oferowanych roślin i ich dobrą kondycję. Corocznie testujemy wiele nowych odmian. Najlepsze z nich wprowadzamy do produkcji, a mniej wartościowe usuwamy. Asortyment jest zatem systematycznie udoskonalany, dlatego w ofercie corocznie znajdują Państwa wiele nowych pozycji.

Our nursery specializes in the production of the ericaceous plants. More than 20 years ago we have initiated in great extent, as the first nursery in Europe, to plant the nursery material propagated in own nursery with the micro-seedling method. Basing on our many-years experience we have elaborated the production technology that ensures the high quality of plants. Nowadays our yearly production is more than 2 million plants, mainly young plants for further production. Part of our plants grow in nursery and is sold further as ready for sale product. We export nearly all new seedlings and approximately 40% of the older material to 25 countries in Europe, as well as to Asian Countries.

Our key product is the rhododendron – over 100 varieties. Additionally, we produce: 30 varieties of azaleas, magnolias, Japanese azaleas, pieris and other ericaceae plants.

Our second largest production branch that is enough popularity is the highbush blueberry – both new and mature bushes. Blueberry also reproduced applying the microseedling method. Currently we offer more than 30 varieties, at the amount of 1 mln.

The separate division of our nursery, namely the coniferous grafted material, includes more than 60 positions.

We make special endeavours to ensure that our plants are high quality and in good condition. Each year we test a number of new varieties.

The best of them are carefully selected for production, while the less valuable ones are removed. Our plant portfolio is, therefore, continuously improved, that's why in our offer each year you will find many new items.

We invite you to visit our nursery and we hope for mutually profitable cooperation.

Unsere Baumschule spezialisiert sich in der Produktion der Heidekrautgewächse. Vor mehr als 20 Jahren haben wir in großem Umfang, als die erste Baumschule in Europa, das Baumschulenmaterial zu pflanzen, das in eigener Baumschule mit der Mikro-Setzling Methode verbreitet wurde. Basierend auf unserer vieljährige Erfahrung haben wir die Produktionstechnologie ausgearbeitet, die Hohen Qualitäten von Pflanzen sichern. Jetzt beträgt unsere Produktion mehr als 2 Millionen Pflanzen, meistens Jungpflanzen für weitere Produktion. Teil unserer Pflanzen bleibt in unserer Baumschule und wird weiter als Fertigwaren verkauft. Junge Pflänzlinge beinahe hundertprozentig, und älteres Material zu ca. 40% exportieren wir in 25 Länder Europas, aber auch in asiatische Länder.

Unser Hauptprodukt ist Rhododendron – über 100 Sorten. Darüber hinaus haben wir in der Produktion: 30 Azalee-Sorten, Magnolien, Japanische Azaleen, Pieris und andere Heidepflanzen.

Der andere große Produktionsbereich, der immer größeres Interesse genießt, ist hohe Heidelbeere – sowohl junge als auch ausgewachsene Sträucher. Heidelbeere wird auch nach der Methode eines Mikropfänzlings fortgepflanzt. Zurzeit bieten wir mehr als 30 Sorten in einer Menge von 1 Million an. Die Unterschiedliche Abteilung unserer Baumschule, nämlich die veredelte Nadelpflanzen, schließt mehr als 60 Positionen ein.

Besonderen Wert legen wir auf die hohe Qualität der angebotenen Pflanzen und deren gute Verfassung. Jedes Jahr testen wir viele neue Sorten. Die besten davon kommen in die Produktion, und die von geringerem Wert werden beseitigt. Мы представляем собой питомник, специализирующийся на производстве вересковых растений. Несколько лет назад мы первыми в Европе начали, в большом масштабе, обрабатывать питомниковый материал, разведенный в собственном питомнике методом микросаженца. Собранный на протяжении многих лет опыт позволил нам дойти до технологии, гарантирующей высокое качество растений. Сейчас объем нашего производства это около 2 млн штук растений. Второй крупный сектор продукции, пользующийся большим спросом, это молодые и взрослые кустарники голубики. Размножение голубики производится также методом микрочеренкования. Сейчас мы производим более 30 сортов в общем количестве 1 млн штук.

В предложении находятся как молодой, так и взрослый посадочный материал.

Третьим, добавочным видом, является хвойный посадочный материал, в котором находится свыше 60 сортов. Особое внимание уделяем высокому качеству предлагаемых растений и их хорошему состоянию. Ежегодно тестируем много новых видов. Самые лучшие из них вводим в производство, а менее качественные удаляем. Таким образом ассортимент систематически совершенствуется и поэтому в нашем предложении ежегодно можете найти много новых позиций.

Green Giants is a new series of rhododendrons created by Swedish breeder Bengt Karlsson, featuring spectacular, enormous leaves resembling exotic rhododendrons. The leaves can reach up to 30 cm in length and about 10 cm in width. They are dark green and can be either glossy or matte. These plants were developed by crossing exotic species with large leaves and species with very high frost resistance. Laboratory tests have shown that they withstand frosts ranging from -20°C to -22°C. In outdoor conditions, they have survived at the lowest recorded temperature of -18°C. The flowers of the varieties in this series are very impressive. The shrubs enter their blooming period at an older age, as several-year-old specimens.

This is a new series of three late-blooming varieties (end of May) with a purple color scheme. All of them are characterized by good vigor, dense growth habit, and excellent hardiness – they are not only frost-resistant (down to -28°C) but also adapted to changing climate conditions (especially to long warm periods during Winter and severe frosts in early Spring). They abundantly form flower buds and are easy to cultivate. The name of the series is inspired by the names of three renowned Polish women from noble families.

The varieties included in the Czech Collection were bred at the Silva Tarouca Institute for Landscape and Ornamental Gardens, v.v.i., Průhonice, Czech Republic. They are distinguished by their exceptionally attractive flower colors and very abundant and long blooming. Some varieties are additionally characterized by their particularly durable, compact inflorescences that can flower for over 3 weeks. Some are characterized by exceptional sun and drought resistance, fragrant flowers or intensely red growths. Most of them are frost resistance down to -24. However, all of them are the result of many years of breeding work and very rigorous selection, effected the selection of varieties with an attractive shape and foliage, as well as good resistance to diseases.

## RHODO KISS



This varieties grown in Cieplucha Nursery. Each of three varieties from RhodoKiss collection is characterized by unique feature. All of them have one thing in common – colour scheme- juicy flower. The collection includes the 'Double Kiss' variety with semi-double flowers, unusual among rhododendrons.'Late Kiss' variety - blooming very late - in the second half of June, and 'Neon Kiss' variety with a bright neon color.



## MUSIC RHODODENDRON COLLECTION



The names of the varieties of this collection (i.e. 'Fryderyk', 'George Sand' and 'Polonez Chopina') were given to commemorate the great composer Fryderyk Chopin. They were created as a result of breeding works initiated by Dr Piotr Muras in the 1990s. The shrubs included in this collection are low or medium sized, with a compact, oval shape, dense, dark green foliage and a large number of shoots. They distinguished by early blooming, good frost resistance (about -24°C), resistance to drought and full sunshine. These varieties are legally protected COBORU in Poland. Registered in The International Rhododendron Register & Checklist (2024).



## RHODO ELITE

Shrubs belonging to this group, which we have named Rhodo Elite, not only looks impressive during the flowering period, but most of all, they astonish with their spectacular leaf appearance for most of the summer time. The collection includes species, primary and second crossings as well as breeding varieties all of them having unusual and attractive leaves, especially young shoots. Within the collection you will find shrubs with leaves covered with tarnish (cutter) in different shades from silvery to copper-brown. There are also shrubs covered with an extremely attractive suede lining underneath of the leaf: silvery or copper. Some of them have fantastic young leaf colours: creamy, silvery, blue or brown-purple that lasts for an entire season! We are convinced that preset varieties and species fully deserved to be called Rhodo Elite. Their frost resistance is not yet known, but we can recommend them because they have survived all winters since 2007, growing in central Poland.

## BRAVA DIVA



**Brava Diva** - the trade name for seedlings of the rhododendron crossbreed (*bureavii* x *pachysanthum*) x (*brachycarpum* x *macabeum*), belonging to the broader group of exceptional rhododendrons known as Rhodo Elita, which includes unique rhododendrons with exceptional characteristics, often featuring attractive indumentum on the leaves. The shrubs belonging to Brava Diva are highly diverse due to the fact that they were created by crossing four species with extremely different characteristics. Their lineage includes species with strong indumentum (*bureavii* x *pachysanthum*), a species with high frost resistance (*brachycarpum*), and a species with enormous leaves (*macabeum*).

Brava Diva rhododendrons may have various colors of indumentum on the leaves – from creamy white through silver to copper. Some plants have more intense indumentum, while others have less. They also significantly differ in growth strength, as well as in the shape and size of the leaves. Laboratory frost resistance tests have shown that they withstand temperature drops to -22°C without damage. In the ground, they have so far survived winter temperatures of -18°C.



**Olympos blueberries** are the result of breeding works made at the Cieplucha Nursery since 2010. Below we present 4 new highbush blueberries:



**Athena<sup>PBR</sup>** - Very early ripening time (before Duke). Tasty fruit – mid size M (3g, 18,5 mm), crunchy with hard peel. Light blue fruit, gathered in loose clusters (easy to pick). Fertile variety similar to Duke. Straight, strong habit.

**Demeter<sup>PBR</sup>** - Early ripening variety (few days after Duke). Fruit size is medium (3g, 17,5 mm), very crispy. Excellent shelf-life, no deterioration of fruit parameters after 4 weeks of storage. Very abundant fruitification (50% more than Duke). Slightly sour fruit, habit – straight and strong.

**Zeus<sup>PBR</sup>** - Mid variety (week after Duke). Big fruit – size XL 3,5g 20 mm, good shelf-life, crunchy. Very abundant fruitification (similar to Draper). Fruit tasty, sweet and sour. Habit – straight and strong.

**Apollo<sup>PBR</sup>** - A late-fruiting blueberry variety (about one week after Draper). The fruits are size (3.3 g, 19 mm), with good shelf life and a crunchy texture. This is a high-yielding variety (yield similar to Draper). Fruits are very tasty, sweet and tangy. The bushes have a good structure, upright and strong.

New varieties will be ready for sale since Autumn 2025.



# PATIO BLUEBERRIES



We present to you licensed varieties of Finnish blueberries. The most important feature of Patio Blueberries is high frost resistance - they can be easily grown on terraces and balconies. Very abundant fruitification and compact form - grow up to about 1,3 m high. The size of fruits depend on the variety from 1 to 1,3 cm.

## BLACKBERRIES



*Rubus fruticosus 'Loch Ness'*

Licensed variety bred on the basis of Loch Tay<sup>PBR</sup>. The fruit is slightly smaller comparing to Loch Tay variety. Bears fruit in two-years-old shoots, very early in July. Resistant to parasites. High frost resistance.

A popular variety with the largest fruit on the market. It bears fruit on two-year-old shoots from August till September. Thornless variety.

# ITALIAN LICENSED RASPBERRIES

We present to you new licensed varieties of raspberries from Italian breeding. They are characterized by early and abundant fruiting on one-year-old canes, as well as large, bright red fruits. Italian raspberries are all about excellent raspberry flavor - **Buon appetito!**

## ***Rubus idaeus 'Magda'* PBR**

A licensed raspberry variety bred by the Italian producer Berryplant. It is a compact plant suitable for container cultivation as well. It bears fruit on one-year-old shoots. The fruits are very tasty, sweet, and juicy. Highly recommended for amateur cultivation.



## ***Rubus idaeus 'Clarita'* PBR**

A licensed raspberry variety bred by the Italian producer Berryplant. It bears fruit on one-year-old and two-year-old shoots (twice a year) - in the spring at the beginning of the season on two-year-old shoots and in the fall on one-year-old shoots. The bush has a straight habit, with strong stems. It is characterized by high frost resistance and uniform ripening of the fruits. The fruits are large, bright red, very tasty, and have excellent shelf life. Recommended for commercial cultivation. Resistant to pests and diseases.



## ***Rubus idaeus 'Himbo Top'*® Rafzaqu**

A Swiss variety of red raspberry that ripens mid-season. Very vigorous and high-yielding. The fruits are large, attractive, shiny, bright red (they do not tend to darken), and range from medium firm to firm. Suitable for direct consumption. Shoots are strong and upright, making harvesting easy. The flavor is intense and refreshing, with a high sugar content and a subtle tart note. Resistant to pests.



## ***Rubus idaeus 'Amaranta'*®**

A raspberry variety bred and patented in Italy by Soc.Agr. Sant'Orsola. Shoots are semi-upright. The plant's structure allows for very easy and quick harvesting. This variety is highly productive. Early flowering period and a mid-late ripening period. The fruits are elongated and cone-shaped, bright red, and very uniform. They offer good shelf life and are resistant to handling. The flavor is excellent.

## ***Rubus idaeus 'Glen Dee'*®**

A Scottish raspberry variety with a classic truncated conical shape and bright red color. It is easy to harvest, has good shelf life, and is thornless. The plant has a vertical growth habit with easy-to-maintain shoots. Lateral shoots are long and strong. Medium ripening period, lasting about 4-5 weeks. The fruits are large, with a sweet and slightly tart flavor.
